Raising awareness for Sepsis from South Warwickshire NHS.

Signs of sepsis might be:

A child who is breathing very fast. Has a 'fit' or convulsion. Looks mottled or pale. Has a rash that does not fade when you press it. Is very lethargic or difficult to wake or feels abnormally cold to touch.

Any child under 5 who:

Is not feeding. Is vomiting repeatedly or hasn't had a wee or wet nappy for 12 hours.
