



<p><u>English</u></p> <p>Over this term there will be a focus on studying a story with a historical setting, We will be looking at the book 'Street Child' by Berlie Doherty and Oliver Twist. We will be learning how to use features of persuasion in our writing and to construct debates.</p> <p>We will be looking at poetry in particular The Highway Man. We will also be looking at features of a recount and biographies.</p>	<p><u>Art &amp; Design</u></p> <p>Our Art work will be based on the designer William Morris. We will be looking at his work and designs and be recreating his ideas, as well as printing and quilting.</p>	<p><u>Topic</u></p> <p>Our topic this term is Crime and Punishment. We will be learning about the broad trends of crime and punishment from the Romans to the 21<sup>st</sup> century. We are also going to be looking at life in the Victorian era and comparing it to life today.</p>	<p><u>Physical Education</u></p> <p>Athletics will be the focus of P.E. lessons for the first half term in preparation for the school games. Children will develop a range of skills and apply these to different track and field events.</p>
<p><u>Mathematics</u></p> <p>This term, we will be following the Mathematics curriculum in Year Six with a focus on place value, addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.</p> <p>In Y6 we will begin revision for SAT's and cover place value; written and mental calculations; problem solving; measuring and reading scales; reading digital and analogue times; collecting, organising and interpreting data; times tables; comparing and ordering angles.</p>	<p><u>Design and Technology</u></p> <p>As part of our work on The Victorians, we will design and make a Victorian toy.</p>	<p><u>Year 6</u></p> <p><b><u>Autumn Term</u></b></p> <p><b><u>Curriculum Plan</u></b></p>	<p><u>ICT</u></p> <p>Children will develop their PowerPoint skills by preparing different presentations during the first few weeks.
