Home Reading Books

Home read book – colour band matched as close as possible to RWI level.

Future plans – RWI home books are being released next year.

Home – FRED games

- A love for reading
- listen to lots of stories
- make up stories
- read other texts (magazines, shopping lists, signs etc)



Home Reading Books

Read Write Inc home books

- They link to the **exact level** they are reading at school (sounds and fluency).
- The story will link to their next story in school, an opportunity for **pre-teaching** at home.
- No sounds or words in the book that your child **is unable to read**.
- Chance for a **celebration** of their reading
- Chance for them to **teach you**, activities at the start of the book identical to school teaching.
- **BRAND NEW!**

How will it work?

Reception children

Whole class teaching up until October half term.

Children assessed and grouped into sound groups Oct-Dec – some children may begin reading the RWI Guided Reading Story books (red)

All children assessed again and grouped into groups to begin in January – some children may begin reading the RWI Story books (green)

When children begin **GREEN** story books at school the children will bring home a matching **HOME READ BOOK**.

I assess the children every 6/8 weeks and they are grouped accordingly, so this will happen at different stages for each child.

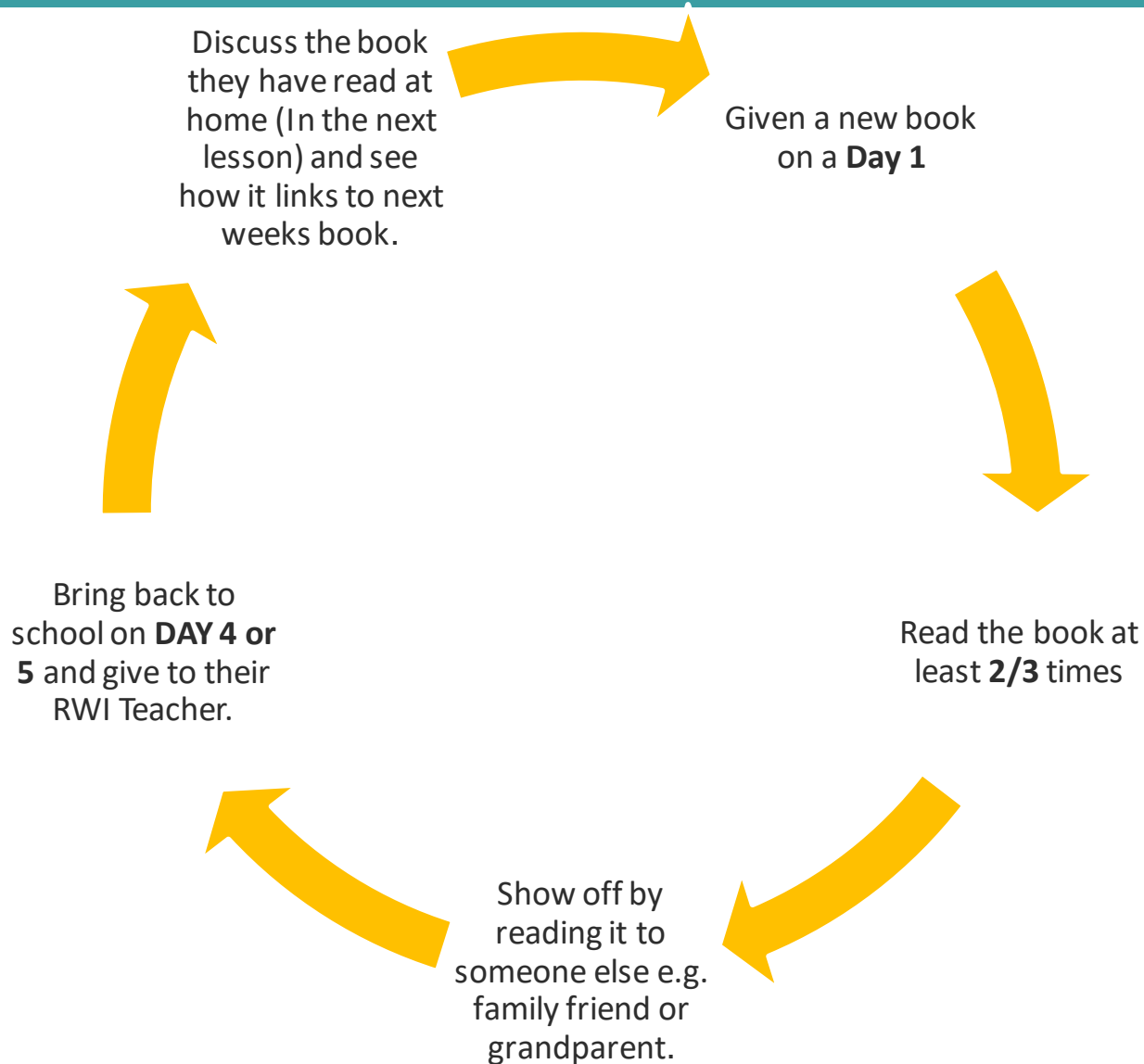
Target groups will happen throughout the year by myself.

How will it work?

Year 1 and Year 2 children

- Home read books are for children in groups **GREEN – YELLOW**
- Children in Blue, Grey or comprehension groups will have extra 'banded home read books'
- Children will be given their RWI home read book by their RWI teacher and this will be given out on **DAY 1**.
- There will be a strict expectation that this book is back in school on **DAY 4 or DAY 5**.
- The book your child will bring home will link to the story they will read in school the following week, fantastic opportunity to **pre teach**.
- This book will be given **alongside** their home reading book they will get off their class teacher.

5 Day Plan

New RWI home read book on a **Monday**.

Must bring back on a **Friday**. Be given a new one the following **Monday**.

How will this work for a 3 or 5 day plan?

3 Day Plan

New RWI book on a **Monday** (Day 1). Bring back to school on **Thursday** (Day 4). Get a new book on **Thursday** (Day 1). Bring back to school on **Tuesday** (Day 1)..... *And so on....*

Ahhhhhhhhhhhh!!!!!!

Read & Return!!

As a parent the easiest way to manage this is every time you have read the book, return it to your child's school bag.

Make it part of your every day routine 😊

How will it work?

What is the difference?

RWI home read book – children should understand the process at the start and **should not** struggle with sounds in the words, should be able to focus on speed and comprehension – this only comes once a book has been read a minimum of 3 times.

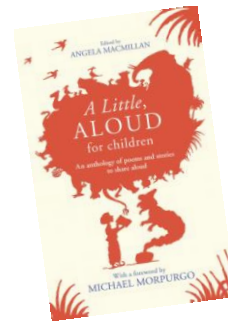
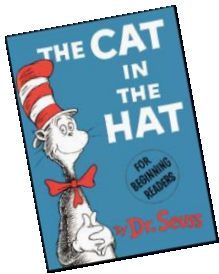
If children are struggling with any sounds or words – note them down so we can ensure we cover extra work in school the following week.

Banded home read books that are given out by your child's class teacher should be read with encouragement and support when needed as they will come across words that will have sounds in that they haven't covered.

- Still read *to* your children
- Ask lots of questions and share opinions
