Remote Learning Offer from March

Dear Parents,

I would like to take this opportunity, to thank you all for your dedication and hard work in supporting us to deliver lessons remotely during this period. Our remote learning provision has developed significantly in the past year, which could not have been possible without your support. The staff are excited to welcome all our pupils back into school on Monday 8th March and for school to become a buzzing hive of learning again!

However, we are still in a period where pupils will need to isolate due to Covid 19. Below I will outline the remote learning provisions that will be offered in the case of individual pupils isolating, class bubble closures and whole school closures.

Individual Pupils Isolating

If your child must isolate, they will be able to continue learning remotely inline with their peers. Every week in the digital classrooms, you will continue to find a

- remote learning timetable that mirrors the learning taking place in school
- relevant resources to support the completion of task.

Please note: no live sessions or pre recorded sessions are offered, so your child can work through the tasks at their own pace.

Please continue to submit your child's work on ClassDojo to be approved and commented on by the Year Group Team.

You will receive wellbeing calls and TEAMS meetings will be offered during this time.

Class Bubble Closure

In the event of a class bubble closure, the following arrangements will take place.

On **Day 1**, you will be asked to follow the remote learning timetable already in the digital classroom, as outlined above. The class teacher will schedule a TEAMS meeting to explain the provisions for the remainder of the bubble closure.

From **Day 2**, the remote learning timetable will have been altered to include:

- timetabled Live and Pre-recorded sessions
- additional supportive resources to complete the tasks
- a daily interactive session.

Please continue to submit your child's work on ClassDojo to be approved and commented on by the Year Group Team.

You will receive wellbeing calls and TEAMS meetings will be offered during this time.

Whole School Closure

In the event of a whole school closure, the following arrangements will take place.

On **Day 1**, you will be asked to follow the remote learning timetable already in the digital classroom, as outlined above. The class teacher will schedule a TEAMS meeting to explain the provisions for the remainder of the bubble closure.

From **Day 2**, the remote learning timetable will have been altered to include:

- timetabled Live and Pre-recorded sessions
- additional supportive resources to complete the tasks
- a daily interactive session
- small group work support sessions

Please continue to submit your child's work on ClassDojo to be approved and commented on by the Year Group Team.

You will receive wellbeing calls and TEAMS meetings will be offered during this time.

Additional Support - Learning

In any of the scenarios above, if your child needs additional support or adjusted resources please communicate with your class teachers. If you require additional support regarding wellbeing, please inform your class teachers in the first instance. You may receive additional support from the Pastoral Team if needed.

Additional Support - Equipment

If during a period of remote learning you require support in accessing or using ICT equipment, please reach out to myself via the school office, and arrangements will be made to support you.

Reminder – if you currently have loaned ICT equipment from the school, please turn this as soon as possible.
