Dear Parents,

We all know that this year has been like 'no other' and the children have had such different experiences to those of a typical academic year. Schools are now tasked at looking into how we can make a difference moving forward.

Teachers are already busy assessing academic gaps and putting a range of interventions into place to support children's Reading, Writing and Mathematical development. However, we know that these are not the only areas of development children have had varied experiences of this year.

As a school, we have placed a high importance on wellbeing and as part of this in school we have introduced 'circle time' and our timetable reflects supporting our children with the challenging year they have had. Alongside this, we know that children have not had the social and physical opportunities they may have had. Therefore, we have invested in some physical development equipment and have arranged for every child in Year Six ahead of leaving Park Hill to take part in our very own 'Park Hill Boot Camp'.

This will not be compulsory however every child will get invited to a 3-week block before the end of the academic year and invited to attend sessions on a Tuesday and Friday 3:45-4:30pm (6 sessions in total). There may be an opportunity for some children to attend more than one block. Children will collect stamps and there will be an incentive for attending every session. The sessions are going to be led by Miss Norcliffe and Mrs Adams with a social, emotional, and physical wellbeing focus. Our aim is to get the children excited about being outdoors and moving!

You will receive an additional letter with more information when your child is invited to attend their block. You will need to fill in the reply slip and we ask that if you are 'opting in' that they attend every session where possible.
