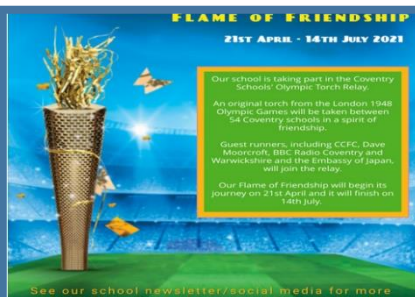
TEACHER LED NURSERY - 2 CLASSES
